Prayer in this petition is for issuance a direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to take appropriate action against respondents No.4 to 13 on the basis of complaint of the petitioner for registration of FIR.

Reply by way of affidavit of Akashdeep Singh Aulakh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Dhuri is filed and as per same, the police has conducted a detailed enquiry and vide enquiry report dated 13.01.2019, no substance was found in the complaint given by the petitioner as the private respondents have already registered an FIR against the petitioner i.e. FIR No.17 dated 03.02.2018 registered under Sections 452, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Sherpur.

In view of the same, the counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail alternative remedy to challenge the enquiry report or to file a criminal complaint before the Illaqa Magistrate, in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
