The petitioners have approached this Court seeking issuance of direction to the police officials to consider their representation for grant of security to the petitioners and to other members of their family as they apprehend threat to the same at the hands of respondents No.5 to 7.

The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that respondents No.5 to 7 have purchased a share of land of the co-sharer of the petitioners and although said co-sharer was not in exclusive possession but on the basis of the said sale-deed the respondents No.5 to 7 are trying to interfere into possession of the petitioners illegally and are threatening to cause harm to them. The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that although petitioner No.1 had submitted a representation dated 25.2.2019 (Annexure P-7) to Superintendent of Police, Karnal but no action has been taken thereupon.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners, the petition is disposed of with a direction that in case any representation is made by the petitioners to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Sonapat seeking security, the same shall be considered by respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Sonapat and shall be disposed of at the earliest, in accordance with law.

A copy of this order be sent to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Sonapat so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
