The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of direction for protection of his life and liberty.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that although he had submitted representation dated 16.3.2019 (Annexure P-1) to S.H.O., Police Station, Tauru, District Nuh and representation dated 20.3.2019 (Annexure P-4) to the Superintendent of Police, Mewat, Nuh but no action has been taken thereupon.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4- Superintendent of Police, District Mewat to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation dated 16.3.2019 (Annexure P-1) and representation dated 20.3.2019 (Annexure P-4), made by petitioner, expeditiously, in accordance with law. In case the allegations levelled therein are found to be well founded, then necessary steps be taken thereupon as warranted under law at the earliest.

A copy of this order alongwith representation dated 16.3.2019 (Annexure P-1) and representation dated 20.3.2019 (Annexure P-4) be sent to respondent No.4- Superintendent of Police, District Mewat so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
