This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 18 dated 12.1.2019 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC at PS Chappar, District Yamuna Nagar.

The allegations is that the petitioner was asked to submit her educational certificates. She submitted the photocopies of the same and one of them was found to be fake.

Counsel for the petitioner states the petitioner had never submitted that document and she is ready to cooperate.

In my opinion, this is not a fit case for custodial interrogation and in view of the facts, I do not deem it appropriate to deny her the concession of bail.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. In the event of arrest she

will be released on bail by the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. The petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 13.5.2019 and as and when her presence is required.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
