FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (Oral)

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jaswinder Singh, Police Station City Kharar District SAS Nagar Mohali submits that in consequence of interim order dated 13.07.2018, the petitioner has since joined the investigation and every articles of “istridhan” including the ones detailed in the orders of this Court dated 13.11.2018 stands recovered and nothing is to be recovered from him and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute. However, Ms. Benti Kaur, learned counsel for the complainant has tried to oppose the grant of bail on the ground that a diamond ring still needs to be recovered.

In view of the oral stand of the parties reflected in the order of this Court dated 13.11.2018 and the stand of the State the order of interim bail dated 13.07.2018 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
