ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 624 dated 04.09.2017 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 307 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Nuh, District Nuh, Mewat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that he along with others has beaten up the injured. She also contends that no specific role has been attributed to the petitioner and the injury, which is attributed to him, is a simple injury. She further contends that he had earlier been granted anticipatory bail by the trial Court on the condition that he shall pay ₹25,000/- to the three injured, i.e. Aalam son of Yakub, Arshad son of Ibrahim and Fakru son of Isrile, in equal share, but he could not do so, as he is a poor person and it took some time to arrange money and now he is ready to pay the amount of ₹25,000/- to the three injured. Learned counsel for the petitioner has brought three drafts for a sum of ₹8334/- each in the name of the three injured namely Aalam son of Yakub, Arshad son of Ibrahim and Fakru son of Isrile.

The aforesaid drafts for a sum of ₹8334/- each in the name of the three injured namely Aalam son of Yakub, Arshad son of Ibrahim and Fakru son of Isrile are handed over to ASI Amar Singh,

Investigating Officer who undertakes that he shall handover the drafts to the three injured within next two days.

This Court, by the order dated 09.04.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Amar Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 09.04.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
Criminal miscellaneous application also stands disposed of.
