Petitioner has filed this second petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in Criminal Appeal No.27 of 2016 (arising out of complaint No.59529/2013 dated 30.04.2013, District Ludhiana), pending before the Court of learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, Ludhiana.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.1-State and contested this petition.

Respondent No.2 has also appeared through its counsel.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned

State counsel and gone through the record.

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Learned counsel for respondent No.2-complainant submits that parties have already effected the compromise and they want to compound the offence.

Keeping in view the facts that the petitioner absented himself from the court proceedings in an appeal; that compromise has already been effected between the parties and that disposal of the appeal may take a long time, I find that no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody. Therefore, finding merit in the present petition, the same is allowed. The petitioner is directed to surrender before the Appellate Court within ten days from today and on doing so, he shall be released on bail by the Appellate Court to its satisfaction. If the petitioner fails to surrender before the Appellate Court within the stipulated period, then this petition shall be treated as dismissed.
