This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.1 to 3 to consider the representations dated 25.1.2019 (Annexures P-2 and P-3).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-The Deputy Commissioner, DC Office, Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib, Punjab to treat the present petition as representation and consider and decide the same expeditiously.

Heard.

A complete set of paper book has been handed over to Mr.Vikas Mohan Gupta, Addl.AG Punjab in the Court today.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to

submit a copy of this petition to respondent No.2-The Deputy Commissioner, DC Office, Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib, Punjab within a period of two weeks from today who shall treat the petition as representation and consider and decide the same within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
