Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.76 dated 02.07.2018 under Sections 498-A, 406, 323, 34, registered at Police Station Sherpur, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that since the very FIR has been quashed by this Court vide order dated 11.10.2018 passed in **CRM-M-44906-2018 (Balveer Singh and another Versus State of Punjab and another)**, the present petition no more survives and the same has been rendered infructuous.
