The petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.50, dated 14.3.2019, registered under Section 61 of the Excise Act, at Police Station Samana, District Patiala.

As per allegations, a raid was conducted at the house of the petitioners and lahan was recovered from their house.

Counsel for the petitioners has argued that no other case is pending against the petitioners.

Learned DAG Punjab, on instructions from HC Jaswant Singh, has accepted that no other case is pending against the petitioners.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Resultantly, this petition is

allowed and it is directed that in the event of their arrest, the petitioners shall be released on anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
