The petitioner is an accused in FIR No.43, dated 03.02.2019 registered at Police Station Bhuna, District Fatehabad, under Section 22 (B) NDPS Act, 1985. According to the FIR, 1520 tablets of Alprazolam were recovered from him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after grant of bail, the petitioner approached the police authorities for a copy of the FSL report but no copy was supplied to him. In fact, it is alleged that a sample has not been sent for analysis to the Forensic Science Laboratory concerned. Thus, a direction be given to the police to send the sample.

In case a sample of the recovered contra-band has not been sent for chemical analysis, the petitioner would get benefit of the same during

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the trial. There is no cause for the petitioner to seek the directions sought for in the present petition.

The petition is totally misconceived and is accordingly dismissed.
