Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Director Local Bodies, Punjab Government, Sector 17, Chandigarh to consider and decide the representation dated 6.2.2019 (Annexure P-6).

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-

In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
