This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 180 dated 12.03.2019, registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 332 and 353 of the IPC at Police Station City Thaneswar, Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is a government employee and is working as Pharmacist Civil Hospital, Sector 22, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, on 12.03.2019, the petitioner was travelling in his car bearing registration number PB-65-AJ-8686 near village Sunderpur and he suddenly stopped his car which resulted into minor accident with the car of complainant Mohinder Singh, who is working as Head Constable in Haryana Police, and was about to ascend the overbridge at the relevant time.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that in fact the grandmother of the petitioner is a cancer patient and he has taken his

grandmother to village Raison for taking medicine from a private person and there was no intention on the part of the petitioner to commit any offence.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has not disputed the factual position and submitted that petitioner is in judicial custody since 14.03.2019.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, considering the aforesaid submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and also in view of the fact that petitioner is in judicial custody since 14.03.2019; the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
