The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 317, dated 04.12.2018, under Sections 307, 324, 323, 452, 34 IPC and Section 326 IPC added subsequently, registered at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is outcome of a sudden quarrel between the neighbours and the petitioner is alleged to have given *datar* blow on the head of the complainant. He further contends that the petitioner is 18 years of age and is a student of Class XI. He also contends that the petitioner is in custody for almost 4 months since his arrest on 11.12.2018 and is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Sarwan Kumar, contends that the complainant has fully recovered from his injuries.

He also contends that investigation has been completed and challan has been presented.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is 18 years of age, he is in custody for over 3 months and not involved in any other case, I deem it appropriate to grant him the concession of regular bail.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
