This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.0011 dated 08.03.2019 registered under Sections 420/465/467/468/471 IPC at Police Station Police Commissionerate P.S. Verka, District Amritsar.

The divorced husband of the petitioner filed a complaint that the petitioner had obtained the job in the year 1997-1998 on the basis of forged degree. Admittedly she had resigned from the job in the year 2009 and the present complaint was filed in the year 2016 after the relationship between the parties have soured.

The primary contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is

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document that in any case the occurrence took place more than 20 years ago the

petitioner is not doing any job. The investigation is complete and her custodial interrogation is not required.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Shiv Kumar has accepted that the investigation into the offence of the petitioner is complete.

In the circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Resultantly, the petition is allowed. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, she shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 16.04.2019 and on any other date as and when her presence is required.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
