The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for directing respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner as well as his family members at the hands of respondents No.4 to 14.

Paper-book reveals that the dispute is regarding Dharamshala between both the parties i.e petitioner as well as private respondents. In response to the notice of motion issued by this Court, reply on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 was filed on 24.03.2017. Perusal of the same reveals that proceedings under Section 107 and 151 Cr.P.C. were initiated against both the parties and even DDR No. 22 dated 19.01.2017 was also recorded at Police Station Mandi Gobindgarh and thereafter, the proceedings under Section 145 Cr.P.C. were initiated.

Learned State counsel has filed the Status report by way of

affidavit of Manpreet Singh, PPS, DSP, Circle Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib in the Court today. The same is taken on record and paragraph No.4 of the above said report reveals that against the order dated 24.07.2017 passed under Section 145 Cr.P.C., the revision petition has been preferred by the petitioner as well as some other aggrieved persons and the same is pending for 23.01.2019 before learned Additional Sessions Judge, Fatehgarh Sahib.

In view of the above, no further directions are required to be issued in the matter, consequently, the present petition is hereby dismissed.

The above observation may not be construed as an expression of opinion on merits of the proceedings before learned Additional Sessions Judge, Fatehgarh Sahib.
