The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.03, dated 9.2.2019, registered under Section 306 of the IPC, at Police Station Ghuman Kalan, District Gurdaspur.

Allegation against the petitioner was that she filed false complaints against her in-laws and as a result of which her brother-in-law (Devar) committed suicide. The deceased left two suicide notes wherein he specifically blamed the petitioner.

Custody certificate has been filed, as per which the petitioner has been in custody for one month and twelve days.

Counsel for the complainant, as well as learned DAG Punjab

have vehemently opposed the prayer for bail. It is stated that because of the petitioner that a young man has lost his life.

Be that as it may, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
