FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

This order shall dispose off first anticipatory bail application filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. by petitioner Jaspal Singh in case bearing FIR No.27 dated 26.05.2018 registered at Police Station Women Cell, Amritsar under Sections 406, 498-A IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 16.07.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from SI Jatinder Singh who submits that the petitioner is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

Though learned counsel for the complainant Mr. Vipul Aggarwal, Advocate has sought to oppose grant of bail on the grounds that the prosecution has charged the accused for commission of offence under Section 313 IPC, however, in view of the stand of the State and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 16.07.2018 is made absolute. He shall however abide by the conditions specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, he will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
