This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for quashing the impugned order dated 11.7.2017 (Annexure P-6) whereby complaint presented under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instrument Act, 1881 has been transferred from the court of competent jurisdiction at Panchkula to a court of competent jurisdiction at Belapur.

Learned counsel for the parties have submitted that parties have entered into a compromise.
