The instant petition has been filed under Sections 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No. 266 dated 10.05.2018 under Sections 323, 34, 377, 498-A, 506 IPC registered at Police Station Quilla, Panipat, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioners herein contends that in fact the matter stands compromised between the parties and statement of the complainant has already been recorded by the Investigating Officer wherein she has stated that she would like to rehabilitate herself in her matrimonial home and she does not want to press her complaint.
