The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, seeking quashing of FIR No.396 dated 21.10.2016 under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code (Sections 467, 468 and 471 of IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Ambala Cantt and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has fairly stated that the cancellation report in the mater has been prepared and the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

On instructions from police official, learned State counsel has acknowledged the above factual position.
