AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

1. At the very outset learned counsel for the petitioners states that inadvertently respondent No.2 has been mentioned as Senior Superintendent of Police, Hissar instead of Superintendent of Police, Hissar in the array of parties as well as in the Annexure P-5 (representation before the Superintendent of Police, Hissar).
2. I find this to be correct. Allowed as prayed for.
3. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.3 and 4.
4. Notice of motion.

5. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Himmat Singh, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2 and requisite sets of paper-book has been supplied to him.

6. The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-1) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 8.11.1998 and petitioner No.2 has also placed on record a copy of Aadhar card (Annexure P-2) depicting his date of birth as 4.10.1995. They have also moved a representation before the Superintendent of Police, Hissar (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

7. Without adverting to the merits of the controversy and validity of marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-the Superintendent of Police, Hissar to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-5).
