Main case

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for grant of protection as the petitioners have entered into a marriage against the wishes of private respondent Nos.4 to 9.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the representation dated 27.03.2019 was given to Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana on the same day when the marriage was performed. As per the version in the representation, the petitioners had informed their respective families about the marriage and in return they received threats.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has placed on record a copy of FIR through CRM-11952-2019 wherein a case FIR No.76 dated

29.03.2019 under Sections 363 and 366 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sahnewal, District Ludhiana stands registered against petitioner No.2. In the above said FIR, it is clearly mentioned by father of petitioner No.1 that his daughter was enticed away by petitioner No.2.

It is not disputed by learned counsel that father of petitioner No.1 has approached the authorities in accordance with law and it is conceded that no untoward incident has taken place much less at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 9.

In view of the conflicting stand, no ground is made out for invoking the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Consequently, petition is dismissed.
