Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 6.

Affidavit dated 09.04.2019 filed by way of affidavit of Gurpreet Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Jaitu, District Faridkot on behalf of State is taken on record. Copy supplied to the counsel opposite. As per the affidavit the police has contacted the private respondents and recorded their statements and they have stated that they have no objection, as their daughter-petitioner No.1 is living happily at her matrimonial house.

Counsel for the petitioners has accepted this fact that now the petitioners have no apprehension or threat to their life and liberty from the private respondents.

In the circumstances, the petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous at this stage.

Since the main case has been dismissed as infructuous, the pending Criminal Miscellaneous Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
