The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.11, dated 31.12.2018, registered under Section 13(1) and 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption (Amendment) Act, 2015, and Sections 409, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the IPC, at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Punjab at SAS Nagar.

After arguing for some time, counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw this petition but states that the petitioner will surrender before the trial Court and a direction be issued to decide his application for regular bail within a reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. Consequently, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn. In case the petitioner surrenders before the trial

Court on 24.5.2019 and moves an application for regular bail, the same be

decided in accordance with law expeditiously but in any case on or before 28.05.2019.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
