The petitioner has moved this petition under Section 482 read with Section 407 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for transfer of case filed under Section 125 of the Cr.P.C. pending before Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Dhuri to competent court of jurisdiction at Ludhiana on the ground that he and his widowed old aged mother are chronic patients of different diseases. It is specifically stated in the petition that the petitioner is partially crippled because of multiple surgeries.

Heard.

The respondent wife as well as her two children are staying at Dhuri. Dhuri court had exclusive jurisdiction in the matter under Section 125 of the Cr.P.C.

A bare perusal of the application under Section 125 of the Cr.P.C. transpires that the respondent wife and her children has no source of income. It is difficult for her to visit Ludhiana.

In this view of the matter, no case is made out for transfer of the case. However, the petitioner may move an application for his examination through video conferencing.
