Petitioner has filed the present petition for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 for setting aside the cancellation report prepared by respondent No.4 in FIR No.74 dated 29.09.2018 under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Division-D, District Amritsar City as it was registered after a detailed enquiry conducted by a senior officer of the rank of ACP, Amritsar.

The whole case of the petitioner is founded on the alleged cancellation prepared by respondent No.4. It is conceded by the learned counsel for the petitioner that no such report has been either filed by the petitioner or is in possession of the petitioner. The averments made in the petition regarding preparation of the cancellation by respondent No.4 are not worth believing and, therefore, no ground is made out to invoke inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

The present petition is dismissed.
