1. Petitioners-Varinderjit Singh and Manjit Singh, seek grant of anticipatory bail in a case registered vide FIR No.45, dated 14.6.2018, registered at Police Station Women, District Amritsar, under Sections 406, 498-A IPC.

2. Vide order dated 10.9.2019, the parties had been referred to Mediation and Conciliation Center at Amritsar which has yielded results. It has been informed that the parties have amicably resolved their issues and pursuant to a settlement reached at amongst the parties, a petition under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act has already been filed wherein their statements on the first motion have also been recorded.
3. In view of the aforestated position where the parties are stated to have resolved their issues, custodial interrogation is not warranted. The petition, as such, is accepted and interim directions issued vide order dated 18.7.2018 are made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioners shall appear and join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
