Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to the official respondents to take appropriate action in FIR No.55 dated 13.06.2018 under Sections 354-A, 509 IPC registered at Women Police Station, District Panipat.

Notice of motion in the case was issued on 17.07.2018 and on asking of the court, while accepting notice, the State-respondents had sought time to file status report in the case.

Accordingly, status report by Vijender Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Panipat, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, has already been filed in the Registry of this Court. As per the status report, L/ASI Sudesh carried out investigation in the case and she joined Krishan son of Dayachand, Sumer son of Mansa Ram, Jagbir son of Jaibhagwan, Shyam Singh son of Jage Ram and Raghubir son of Prita in the investigation. They have submitted their respective affidavits that respondent No.4-Jai Kumar son of Jage Ram was paralysed and was unable

to move and stand up at his own. In this respect, they also produced permanent disability certificate of respondent No.4. After enquiry, it has been concluded that the facts of FIR are totally false and baseless and no concrete evidence has come forward to arrest the accused. Status report further reveals that after investigation, the police has already prepared cancellation report on 02.08.2018 and the same is being sent to the higher authorities for necessary approval.

Considering the prayer i.e. direction to take appropriate action on the basis of allegations and correlating the contents of the status report wherein it has been submitted that cancellation report has been prepared in the case, this Court finds that no further direction can be issued in the case.

Disposed of.

However, in the event of cancellation report being submitted in the case, the petitioner may avail the remedy as available under law.

In case the petitioner disputes the aforesaid facts, she may seek revival of this petition.
