Present petition under Section 438 of the Criminal Procedure Code is for grant of pre-arrest bail to petitioner-Ravneet Kaur in case F.I.R. No.67 dated 04.04.2018 under Sections 420, 406, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Gurdaspur.

In terms of order dated 12.06.2019, the petitioner has already deposited a sum of Rs.20,60,000/-, which was the amount due against her. At this stage, prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner is that the petitioner is permanent resident of Italy and wants to visit Italy for a period of one month or so so as to get her P.R. card re-validated.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sarwan Singh, contended that the petitioner has already joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant contended that the petitioner and her family members are settled in abroad and there is every likelihood that she will not come back, as such, strict condition be imposed and heavy surety amount be ordered.

In view of the above, the order dated 12.06.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Necessary permission is granted to the petitioner for a period of one month to visit Italy and get her P.R. card re-validated and for that purpose, learned trial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate shall pass an order so that adequate surety bonds be obtained.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
