Petitioner-Bhawna has filed this petition for issuance of directions to the official respondents for registration of the FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that despite a complaint given no FIR has been registered. It is the case of the petitioner that a vehicle was purchased from private respondent No.3 and a sum of Rs.65,000/- was paid towards down payment. It is contended that the second hand vehicle was offered by respondent No.3, which was not accepted by the petitioner.

Considering the nature of the allegations, no case is made out for invoking the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C as the alternative remedy in law is available.

Dismissed.
