In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that promotional increment, which was granted to him vide order dated 21.08.2018 was withdrawn by the respondents on 14.03.2019 (Annexure P-15) without giving any opportunity of hearing to him to represent his case.

Learned counsel for the respondents on instructions from Er. Gurbhej Singh, SDO, Nangal, states that the impugned order dated 14.03.2019 (Annexure P-15) be treated as withdrawn with liberty to the respondents to pass a fresh order in accordance with law after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the respondents that the impugned order will be withdrawn by the respondents and they will pass a fresh order in accordance with law, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and has been disposed of as such with liberty to the respondents, as prayed for.
