FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (Oral)

This order shall dispose off a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 63 dated 20.04.2018 under Sections 498-A, 406 and 120 IPC Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur on the basis of compromise.

Pursuant to order dated 30.01.2019 passed by this Court, private parties to this petition have put in appearance and during the course of interaction with the parties, it has transpired that they have compromised the matter and resolved to end the dispute. Their statements regarding compromise is recorded.

Heard.

In the light of joint statement made by the parties and together with the fact that the dispute between the parties being a pure matrimonial and the offence for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 63 dated 20.04.2018 registered at Police Station Bhawanigarh, under Sections 498-A, 406/120-B IPC, District Sangrur and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners is quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
