MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for quashing of order dated 07.11.2013 (Annexure P-4) passed in FIR No.113 dated 11.06.2011 registered under Sections 307, 452 and 148 read with Section 149 Indian Penal Code and Sections 25, 27, 54 and 59 of Arms Act at Police Station Sadar, Amritsar whereby the petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender.

The petition filed on the basis of compromise allegedly entered into between the petitioner and the complainant, namely, Gurpreet Singh. In that regard, an affidavit on behalf of the complainant dated 25.07.2016 is appended with the petition as Annexure P-2.

Considering the solitary ground raised by the petitioner i.e compromise, this Court is not inclined to accept the same as the offence punishable under Section 307 IPC cannot be compounded on the basis of the compromise. Besides, no interest has been shown by the

petitioner in pursuing this petition.

Resultantly, petition fails and stands dismissed.
