TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA.J (Oral)

Petitioner raises a grievance that private respondent no.9, who is a partner in the business which is being run jointly and with an oblique motive to take over the entire business is threatening the petitioner and by labeling him a drug addict wants him to be forcibly admitted to a private drug addiction centre i.e. respondent no.11 and which is stated to be running without due authorization or permission.

Prayer is for issuance of directions to the official respondents to provide adequate security for the protection of his life and liberty.

Having heard counsel for the petitioner at length and having perused the pleadings on record, liberty is granted to the petitioner to approach respondent no.5 i.e. S.S.P., Mohali as regards his grievance and threat perception at the hands of respondent no.9. In the eventuality of any such representation being filed, respondent no.5 would be obligated to examine the same and to get an inquiry conducted, if, deemed fit and thereafter to take steps as warranted in accordance with law.
