As per pleadings on record, petitioner was involved in case FIR No.33 dated 29.03.2009 under Sections 457/380/411/401 IPC and was convicted by the trial Court on 02.12.2011.

Counsel submits that petitioner has already undergone the sentence imposed.

The short grievance raised in the instant writ petition is that in spite of a period of more than five years having elapsed since the judgment of conviction, an application submitted by him for issuance of passport is not being processed by the Passport Office, Amritsar and the same is still pending.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Shiv Kumar Sharma, Advocate, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent authorities and waives service. A

complete copy of the writ paper-book already stands furnished to counsel for the respondents.

Statement of Mr. Shiv Kumar Sharma, Advocate, is recorded to the effect that in case the application of the petitioner for issuance of a passport is still pending, the same would be processed in accordance with law and as per the provisions of the Passport Act and a final decision would be conveyed to the petitioner positively within a period of six weeks from today.

In the light of such statement recorded of the counsel representing the respondents, no further directions are required to be passed.

Writ petition disposed of.
