Review of the judgment passed on 28.02.2019 has been sought on the ground that the respondents were not heard.

Keeping in view the prayer made, learned counsel appearing for the review applicant-respondent No.1 was heard on merits. He has pointed out certain discrepancies in the oral evidence and submitted that these discrepancies give rise to a suspicion with regard to genuineness of a registered power of attorney.

This Court has examined the discrepancies and found that minor variations in the oral evidence cannot be made the ground to hold that registered power of attorney proved by attesting witnesses was wrong.

In view thereof, no ground is made out for review of the judgment.

Dismissed.
