Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to decide the representations dated 03.04.2017 (Annexure P-3) and dated 04.05.2018 (Annexure P-4).

During the course of arguments, it transpired that the grievance of the petitioner is that a new motorcycle, which was purchased by petitioner No. 2 Raj Kumar, was impounded by the police and later on, the same was misplaced from the custody of the police and despite repeated representations, given by the petitioners, no action is being taken on.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jaspal Singh, submits that petitioners may be directed to file a detailed representation to Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur within a period of one week from today which will be decided by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur within a period of one month thereafter.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed with a direction to the petitioners to file a detailed representation to Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur within a period of one week from today with a further direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur that on receiving such representation from the petitioners, the same will be decided within a month thereafter, after affording opportunity of personal hearing to the petitioners.
