The petitioner was granted regular bail and according to him he was appearing on every date of hearing. On 17.04.2018, he could not appear as his counsel had noted a wrong date and, thus, his bail was cancelled and non-bailable warrants of arrest were issued. It is further averred that meanwhile the co-accused have been acquitted and, thus, the petitioner may be granted anticipatory bail.

Although, it is quite likely that the petitioner will also be acquitted. However, I can not lose sight of the fact that he has absconded from the law for one year without any sufficient reason.

Thus, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court on or before 08.04.2019 and seek regular bail. In case such an application is filed, the trial Court shall allow the same subject to its satisfaction and also subject to the condition that the petitioner shall deposit Rs. 10,000/- as costs in favour of the High Court Legal Services Committee, Chandigarh and shall produce receipt thereof before it.
