The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.169, dated 27.7.2017, registered under Section 15 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Raman, District Bathinda.

On 12.4.2019, the following order was passed :-

“ This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for direction to the trial Court to release the petitioner on anticipatory bail in FIR No.169 dated 27.7.2017 registered under Section 15 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Raman, District Bathinda.

As per the record, the petitioner was granted bail but he did not appear on one date i.e. 28.08.2018 and his bail bonds was cancelled. The precise contention of the counsel for the petitioner is that the petitioner was in jail in Madhya Pradesh in another case of the NDPS Act. In the present case, there is a recovery of 10 kg of poppy husk.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms.Amarjit Kaur Khurana, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the

respondent.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to supply a copy of the petition to the learned State counsel during the course of the day.

To come up on 30.04.2019. In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court on the date fixed which is stated to be 19.04.2019 and the trial Court shall release him on interim bail to its satisfaction.”

Learned DAG Punjab, on instructions from ASI Sukhpal Singh, has accepted the above factual averments, and has stated that the petitioner appeared before the trial Court and was granted interim bail.

In the circumstances, this petition is allowed and the trial Court is directed to confirm the interim order.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
