Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 7 as they have solemnized marriage on 28.03.2019 against the wishes of private respondents.

Learned State counsel has apprised the Court that statements of respondent Nos.4, 5 and 7 by way of affidavit have been recorded wherein they have stated that now they have no relation with the girl and at least there shall be no harm to them at their instance.

At this Mr. Gursimran Singh Jossan, Advocate appears on behalf of respondent Nos.4 and 5 and reiterates the same stand.

In view of the above, no ground is made out for invoking inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Petition is dismissed.
