GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)

The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in a case registered vide FIR No. 5 dated 3.1.2019, Police Station Narwana City, District Jind, under Section 174-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860.

The petitioner, who had been arrayed as an accused in a complaint under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act had been declared a proclaimed person vide order dated 29.11.2018.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has informed that infact the main complaint itself was compromised and stands withdrawn on 25.3.2019.

The aforesaid position is not disputed by the learned State counsel.

The learned counsel has drawn the attention of this Court to order dated 25.3.2019 from which it is evident that the complaint stands withdrawn.

In view of the aforestated position, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose would be served by further detaining the petitioner behind bars. The petition, as such, is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The present petition stands accepted accordingly.
