GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)

The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in a case registered vide FIR No. 375 dated 24.12.2018, Police Station Narwana City, District Jind, under Section 174-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860.

The petitioner, who had been arrayed as an accused in a complaint under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act had been declared a proclaimed person vide order dated 21.11.2018.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has informed that in the present case the matter has been resolved amongst the parties and the amount settled has already been paid to the complainant and that a formal

application for withdrawal of the complaint has already been moved before the trial Court although final order is yet to be passed.

In view of the aforestated position, where the matter is stated to have been compromised, no useful purpose would be served by further detaining the petitioner behind bars. The petition, as such, is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The present petition stands accepted accordingly.
