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KRISHNA MURARI, C.J. (ORAL)

The petitioner has approached this Court seeking a mandamus to command the respondents to accept the technical bid of the petitioner since he failed to upload it due to technical glitch and error on the website on account of network issue.

2. From a perusal of the pleadings made in the writ petition, we do not find any material on record to substantiate the allegations that the bid could not be uploaded on account of the fact that the server stopped responding. The period during which the bid document could have been uploaded was from 09.03.2019 to 28.03.2019. It is unbelievable that the server would be down continuously for such a long period. Prima-facie, it appears that the petitioner failed to upload his bid document within time and has approached this Court setting up a plea that the uploading could not be carried out due to technical error. In the absence of any material to substantiate the allegations, we do not find any reason to entertain the writ petition.

3. The same accordingly stands dismissed.
