Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No. 08 dated 05.12.2008, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 471, 120-B and 511 of the IPC, registered at Police Station NRI, Jalandhar as well as the order dated 13.08.2009, vide which, the petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite making best efforts, he has not been able to contact the petitioner who is presently residing abroad, however, further submits that Chief Judicial Magistrate (NRI cases), Jalandhar, vide judgment dated 05.01.2015, has acquitted four other co-accused, namely Kulwinder Singh, Raninder Singh @ Nanna, Inderjit Singh and Resham Singh, after holding a full length trial. A copy of the judgment is placed on record.

In view of the above, this petition is rendered infructuous.

However, liberty is granted to petitioner to file a fresh petition with better particulars.
