This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner dated 14.03.2018 (Annexure P-3) and representation dated 14.01.2019 (Annexure P-4) and further for registration of criminal case against the private respondents No.5 to 12.

It is contended that respondent No.5 has ignored the stay orders passed by the civil Courts and proceeded to register the sale deed No.562 in favour of Ashok Kumar and Kamaljit Singh. Admittedly, the civil Court is seized of the matter and, violation of stay order can be brought to the notice of the civil court.

In view of the aforesaid, no case is made out for invoking the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Petition is dismissed.
