Petitioners have approached this Court under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking protection of their life and liberty allegedly faced by them at the hands of private respondents No.4 and 5 (parents of the girl). It is pleaded that the petitioners entered into a marriage on 28.03.2019 and a representation stands given to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala. The perusal of the representation (Annexure P-4) reveals that same is dated 29.03.2019 and to a query put by the Court, counsel for the petitioners has produced a receipt dated 29.03.2019 issued by the courier company. It is clear that the request so made by the petitioners before the the Senior Superintendent of Police is yet to reach his office.

In view of the above, the present petition is pre-mature and no ground is made out to invoke the inherent powers of jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Dismissed.
