Allegations against the petitioner Amarjot alias Pamma in this first anticipatory bail application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.28 dated 29.01.2019 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC pertaining to Police Station Phillaur, Police District Jalandhar Rural, are to the effect that marriage between the petitioner and complainant Manisha took place on 24.09.2012 where sufficient dowry articles were given, however, on account of a matrimonial dispute arisen because of more demand of dowry and cash, present case was got registered.

On behalf of the State, Mr. Harbir Sandhu, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab on instructions from ASI Nirmal Singh submits that since the entire dowry articles have been recovered, nothing remains to be recovered from the petitioner and that the petitioner is no

more required for investigation and he has no objection in allowing the relief.

In view thereof, this Court is of the opinion that it would be a travesty of justice to send the petitioner in custody in the present case. Accordingly, in the event of arrest, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). He shall continue to join investigation and shall furnish an undertaking that he shall abide by the conditions specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
