Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for quashing of FIR No.272 dated 10.10.2013 registered under Sections 411, 414, 489-A, 489-B, 489-C and 489-D of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Sections 15, 18, 21 and 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, Section 14 of Foreigners Act, 1946 and Sections 3, 34 and 20 of I.P.Act at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

On 03.07.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Ms. Sudeepti Sharma, Addl. A.G., Punjab is directed to find out the status of investigation in case FIR No.272 dated 10.10.2013 under Sections 411, 414, 489-A, 489-B, 489-C, 489-D IPC, Sections 15, 18, 21, 22 of NDPS, Section 25 Arms Act, Section 14 Foreigners Act and Sections 3, 34, 20 IP Act registered at Police Station City Tarn

Taran, District Tarn Taran as alleged in the present petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to supply three sets of the paper book.

Adjourned to 07.08.2019.”

Today, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Manjinder Singh has apprised the Court that the investigation in the above mentioned FIR is already complete and all the accused except Satnam Singh were found innocent. He submits that the final report under Section 173 (2) Cr.P.C stands filed before the Court of competent jurisdiction.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press this petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
