Despite the case having been called out twice, none is present on behalf of the appellant, nor any request for pass over has been made.

Apart from above, vide order dated 30.4.2018, while taking note of the fact that notice to respondent Nos.1 and 2 could not be issued for want of correct address, fresh notice was ordered for 31.8.2018 through ordinary process, registered post and dasti as well on furnishing of their correct addresses, process fee requisite number of copies of paper book registered cover and incidental expenses within a period of three weeks from 30.4.2018. It was further clarified that in case of non-compliance of the order in its letter and spirit, the appeal shall stand dismissed for non-prosecution.

Office report reveals that respondent Nos.1 and 2 were unserved for want of correct address.

In the circumstances, the appeal is dismissed for want of prosecution in terms of order dated 30.4.2018.
